

SAFE SIDEWALK ACCESS FROM STEPHENSON AVE TO DANFORTH GO

A COMMUNITY PROPOSAL FOR SAFETY, ACCESSIBILITY & GROWTH THE PROBLEM

- Only access is via Main & Danforth crossing (site of fatal collisions in 2021 + 2025).
- Unsafe Stephenson stairs: steep, unlit, often misused, inaccessible for seniors or people with mobility needs.
- Danforth GO has just one entry point, unlike most GO stations. With new condos and higher density, this creates congestion and unsafe crowding.

THE SOLUTION

- A safe, direct sidewalk connection from Stephenson Ave to the GO North Platform, running along the HydroOne site at 165 Stephenson Ave.
- Uses vacant space already beside HydroOne's upgrades.
- Can be integrated with upcoming Metrolinx track/station construction.
- Includes proper lighting, grading, and accessibility features.

WHY NOW

- Danforth GO is already undergoing major track and station upgrades.
- Coordinating this sidewalk project minimizes cost and disruption.
- The community is growing fast — this is the right time to plan for safety, accessibility, and multiple access points.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

- Petition launched with 100+ signatures in the first week (and growing).
- Backed by residents, families, and commuters who rely on Danforth GO daily.
